A Compromise on Christianity

Both organizations built their foundations on Christ, and they continue to stay true to Him when the whole world ridicules them. When people were calling for a boycott on Chick-fil-a, and A&E was trying to remove Duck Dynasty off the air because of their beliefs on homosexuality, both Dan Cathy and Pihl Robertson stood firm on their stance that homosexuality is a sin. They never wavered, even when faced with threats to their success and finances, and God blessed them for it.

Just as they did with these two organizations, everywhere we look the culture today bombards us with sermons on “tolerance”, “not judging anyone else”, and “loving everyone.” I have heard people who claim to be Christians use this lingo. Let’s make this clear: we SHOULD love everyone, regardless of their flaws and beliefs; we SHOULD NOT be so self-righteous that we are judging anyone else. However, judging someone is NOT the same as disagreeing with someone’s beliefs. Just because I think homosexuality is a sin does not mean I am being judgmental of them. I am simply stating the truth based on the Bible. Our culture wants Christians to believe that we cannot have any other beliefs than the world’s or we are intolerant. It is to the point where Christians are compromising on their beliefs to please the world. That cannot happen. We are called to spread the Gospel to the world, but we cannot do that if we are compromising our beliefs. Jesus did not say that there were many ways to Him; that He could be reached through different religions. He said there was one way only, so we are doing the world an injustice by changing Jesus’ message or altering our beliefs to fit the world’s. Duck Dynasty and Chick-fil-a continue to be awesome examples on how to stay true to one’s beliefs even when the world is against you. We cannot compromise on anything, regardless of what the world threatens to do to us.
